- In order to complete your application, you must include at least three (3) <u>current images.</u> Photos should be highquality (at least 200-300 dpi) and well framed shots that clearly demonstrate your work.

BOOTH FEES: Electricity, Drapery, and a 2' storage space running behind your booth is included in your booth fee. Please plan on using this storage space (entering and exiting) **through the back of your booth**. Provide your choice below.

Single Booth	10' x 10'	\$275
Corner Booth	10' x 10'	\$350 - limited
Double Booth	20' x 10'	\$500

Please bring your own heavy duty extension cord, power strip and lighting to connect to the ballroom's electric. Even though the ballroom has LED lighting, the high ceiling and the 8' pipe and drape that defines your booth space diminishes the lighting in your booth. We encourage you to use LED lighting if possible.

CHECK THE JURIED MEDIUM(S) YOU WILL BE EXHIBITING.

You Must Stay Within Your Juried Acceptance Criteria

2D & 3D "Mixed Media" – Works that incorporate more than one type of physical material in their production. Mixed Media should include more than one of the following: paint, pencil, watercolor, photography, printmaking or drawing, fabric, clay work, fiber, glass, metal, wood, or any other found object. **No jewelry.**

Ceramics – All original clay, porcelain and polymer clay. **No jewelry.** If multiple pieces of the same design are displayed, the artist must sign each piece. Machine-made and mass-produced work is not permitted.

Drawing & Pastels – Works created using dry media including chalk, charcoal, pastels, pencil, wax crayons, etc. or from fluid medium of inks and washes applied by pen or brush.

Fiber– All work crafted from fibers, including basketry, embroidery, weaving, tapestry and papermaking. **No jewelry.** No machine-tooled, machine-screened patterns or miscellaneous forms of mass production permitted. No factory produced items, regardless of additional modifications or enhancements may be exhibited.

Glass – Glass works that are functional or decorative by design and are kiln-formed or have been crafted by glass blowing, molding, or casting. Works may be etched or engraved. **No jewelry**. No forms of mass production permitted.

Jewelry – ALL jewelry (any ornaments worn for personal adornments), whether produced from metal, glass, clay, fiber, paper, plastic, leather, or other materials. No commercial casts, molds or production studio work is allowed. **Limited use** of pre-made material such as beads or small ornamental items. *Jewelry will be limited to 25% of show participants, with a balance of mediums within jewelry (glass, silver, copper, clay, fiber, etc.)

Leather - Work where the primary material is leather or repurposed leather including belts, handbags, wearables and sculptural work. **No jewelry**. No factory produced items, regardless of additional modifications or enhancements may be exhibited.

Metal – Includes all non-sculptural work crafted from metals. No production studio work is allowed. **No Jewelry.**

Painting – Works created in oils, acrylics, watercolor, etc. Limited reproductions from original paintings on paper, aluminum, wood, fabric, canvas, ceramics, and porcelain are limited to 25%.

Photography – The process of capturing images that begins with a camera lens, then printing the images, by chemical or digital means, onto a surface. The photography category includes traditional film photography that has not been manipulated to achieve results beyond what could be done in a traditional darkroom. Prints must have been processed by the artists. In addition to the above, the surface on which the photographs are printed must be identified in the description. Limited reproductions from original prints are limited to 25%.

Printmaking & Graphics – Printed works in which the artist hand-manipulated the plates, stones, or screens. Prints must be signed and numbered as a limited edition. Printmakers are required to disclose their printing process. No clothing.

Sculpture – Three-dimensional original work created in any medium that is carved, chiseled and/or cast.

Wood – Original works that are hand-tooled, machine-worked, turned or carved.

Fine Crafts – Original works that are not produced with kits. Only Juried accepted/approved work. **No jewelry.**
